**ALL CLASSES ARE OPEN TO ALL**, unaffiliated, non members & Club Members of British Showjumping. Should a non BS member gain points, these points may be retained if the non member joins British Showjumping as a Club Member within seven days of each show.

To follow (not before 10.30)	2	70cms / 2'3" approx	Open to All - British Showjumping Club - Horses and Ponies. Table A7 – see definition below
To follow (11.30 approx)	3	80cms / 2'7" approx	Open to All - British Showjumping Club - Horses and Ponies. Table A7 – see definition below
To follow (12.15 approx)	4	85cms / 2'9" approx	Unaffiliated – open to horses and ponies. Table A7 – see definition below
To follow (Not before 1pm)	5	90cms / 2'11" approx	Open to All - British Showjumping Club - Horses and Ponies. Table A7 – see definition below
To follow	6	1m / 3'3" approx	Open to All - British Showjumping Club - Horses and Ponies. Table A7 – see definition below
To follow	7	1.05m / 3'6" approx	Open to All - Unaffiliated – open to horses and ponies. Table A7 – see definition below

CONT'D OVERLEAF....

**British Showjumping Eligibility** - For any horse/ rider, pony/rider combination without a registered result in National Amateur 90cm, British Novice, Pony British Novice, Stepping Stones and above in the last 3 years.

Pony classes are open to any age rider. Children can ride horses from the beginning of the calendar year in which the age of 12 is reached (FEI Rules).

**Faults –**

<b>Knock Down</b>	<b>4 Faults</b>
<b>First Refusal</b>	<b>4 Faults</b>
<b>Second refusal (anywhere on the course)</b>	<b>4 Faults</b>
<b>Third Refusal (anywhere on the course)</b>	<b>Elimination</b>
<b>Fall (anywhere on the course)</b>	<b>Elimination</b>

**NB. At British Showjumping Club Competitions the first round or first phase of the competitions, time faults will not be allocated instead there will be a time limit of 2 minutes, competitors who exceed this will incur elimination.**

Horses/ponies may only enter once in any class.

The British Showjumping Club League will run from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2012 – 31<sup>st</sup> May 2013. Club league points will be awarded to horse/pony & rider combinations who must be Club Members of the BS to gain the points. Club league points will be awarded as follows –

1<sup>st</sup> = 12      2<sup>nd</sup> = 10      3<sup>rd</sup> = 8      4<sup>th</sup> = 6      5<sup>th</sup> = 4      6<sup>th</sup> = 3.

**3 points will be awarded to all double clear's including an extra 3 points to prize winners if a double clear has been jumped.**

Class Format Definitions

A7 – One round with Jump Off. Competitors complete their first round not against the clock. After all competitors have completed their first round those who have the least faults qualify to go into a Jump Off round which is a shortened course against the clock.

Single Phase – The course is split in to two sections with 5-7 fences in each section, the second section is timed and the faults are accumulated over both sections. Unless eliminated competitors complete both sections.

Two Phase – This competition comprises of two phases, the first phase is a course of 7 to 9 obstacles, and the second phase takes place over 4 to 6 obstacles. Competitors who receive faults in the first phase of the course do not continue to the second phase and are halted by the bell after they have jumped the last obstacle of the first phase. Those who do not receive faults in the first phase continue to the second phase course which is timed.
